



**Why shouldn't the racks be just as beautiful as the wine? Things to consider when choosing a quality wine rack...**



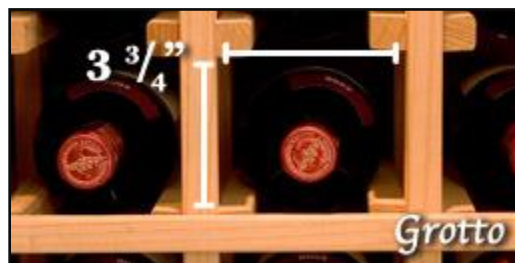
*True-radius curves give the Curved Corner Display Rack an updated, furniture-like appearance.*



*A 1 1/2" toe-kick provides added rack stability, as well as protection for bottles stored below.*



*Completely concealed hardware allows you and your guests to focus on the wine, rather than unsightly screws and tasteless screw covers.*



*3 3/4" bottle cubicles within standard racking will ensure an ideal fit for most 750's, oddly-shaped bottles, and even some Champagne.*



*Notched dados will provide for a simpler installation, as well as a sturdier finished product. Grotto provides a dado on the top, bottom, front, and back of the rack.*



*Odorless wood species naturally resistant to decay will provide the ideal environment for long-term applications. Species such as a Poplar, Birch, and Cedar of any kind should be avoided at all cost.*



*Triple-sanded, angled "easy edge" bottle supports will ensure a safe place for your wine without tearing labels. Watch out for 90 degree sharp bottle supports.*



*Wood thickness of 11/16" for all ladders and bottles supports has been proven to provide essential rack stability, as well a refined modern appearance.*
